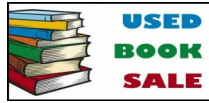

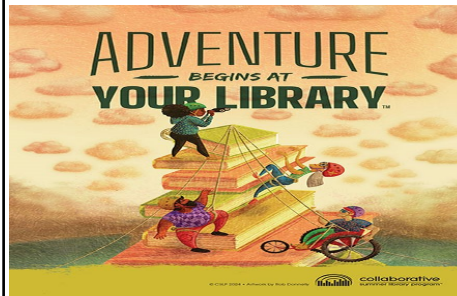
#### Guessing Jar for Everyone

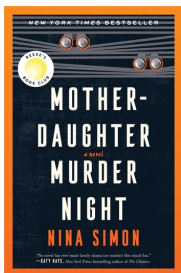

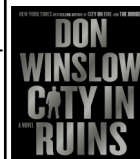
A grandma, single mom, and teenage girl come together to solve the murder of a naturalist who washes up in the Monterey Bay.

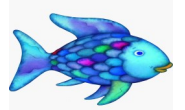

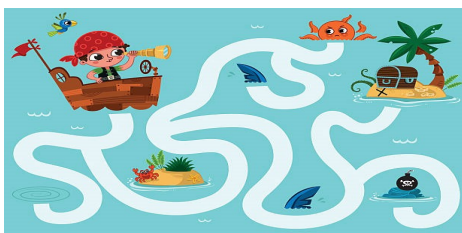
