Hoopla - Borrow free comics, digital video, music, and audiobooks with your library card. All titles are downloadable.

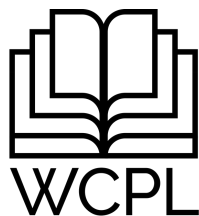


OverDrive - Borrow audiobooks and ebooks for your eReader, mp3 player, smartphone, tablet, or computer.

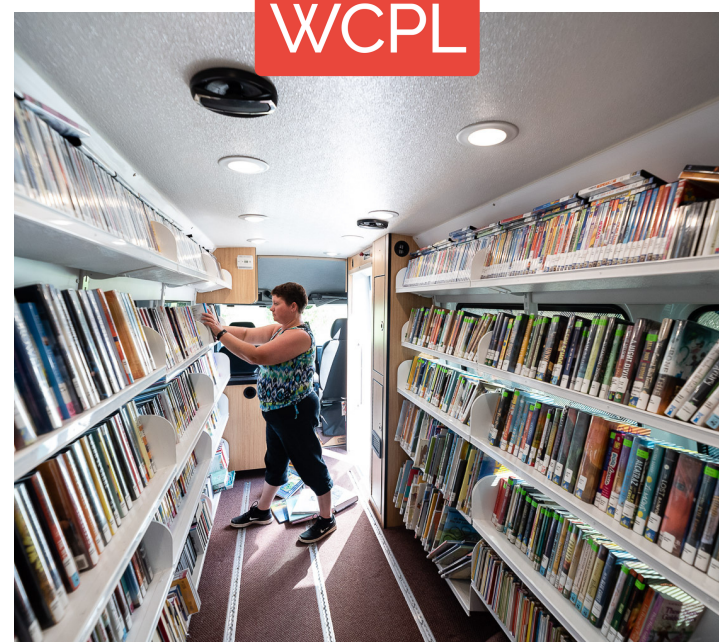
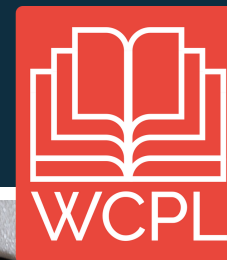
